I first met Gail Millar about a month ago. This was on a night that there was a blizzard. This was a Saturday night because I didn't have to work the next day.

Gail Millar was brought to this party by Dwayne Longdo. On this occasion Dwayne Longdo had too much to drink and he gave Gail Millar heck. He was not really mad by he swears a lot when he is drinking. I was not there at the time this happened. I heard about it from Dwayne himself. He said nothing of what it was about. I believe he phoned Gail Millar and apologised for his actions.

The people at this party were Bryon Odegard, Linda from upstairs 1308 Temperance also Pat from 1308 Temperance. I am not sure who all was there as I had been out and came home about 1 a.m.

When I took Gail Millar home on January 30, 1969. I would arrive around 1:30 pm. She had asked to go home. When I was parked in my car in front of 130 Avenue "O" So. There was about a 1963 or 1964 Pontiac Parissenne across the street heading south. There was one male occupant in this car. The car was Reddish brown on the bottom and a light color top. The light color top was not snow or frost. The left rear was quite badly damaged. The damage would be on the whole quarter panel.

The man in it I would say was about 5'10" tall - 160 pound. Dark hair combed back in a duck tail. This person had kept look towards us while parked and looked away when I looked towards him. I never said anything to Gail about this car & she said nothing about it. I have only seen Les Spence at the funeral, I couldn't say if it was him in this car or not. I did not see anyone at the Funeral that I recognized as the person in this car. I don't think I would know this person if I saw him again.

I have never had intercourse with Gail Millar at any time. I do not know of anyone who ever did have intercourse with her. I do not think Gail Millar was the type of a girl a man could have intercourse with unless possibly they were engaged to her.

I spoke with a person about 21 years old this morning in Otto's Inn, Sutherland Hotel, This person's last name is Elliott. He works night shift at the COOP Feed Mill. He said his cousin used to go with Gail Millar. He didn't say his cousin's name.

On Friday January 31 about 6:00 pm I learned of Gail Millar's death. I had a date with her for Friday Night. I was to pick her up at 8:00 pm. Sig Holle told me about it when I came home from work I had been working at 2211 York Avenue, remodelling a basement. They asked me to drive Linda Markwart home. Forrest Studer and Linda Markwart went with me to 130 Ave. "O". So. I saw the police at 130 Avenue "O" So when I arrived.

From Betty Hundt's room at 130 Avenue "O" So. I phoned my mother at Indian Head, Sask. collect I asked her if she had heard of the stabbing up here. I told her I was involved in it. She asked if I wanted my older brother to come up. I said don't bother. I'll phone you back after everything is over.

After this I phoned my girlfriend Evelyn Olfert 807 Avenue "I" No.

On Saturday Feb 1, I spoke to Don Lane, superintendent at MacCosham's for time off because of this incident. I asked for a week off and it was granted. I gave my car a 1965 Plymouth, Dark red color to Evelyn Olfert and took the Regina Bus which leaves at 140 p.m.

I phoned Saskatoon Police on Saturday nite when I arrived home. I recalled seeing the Pontiac car on Avenue "O" while travelling on the bus and I had not recalled this earlier when seen by Police.

I returned to Saskatoon on Sunday night as police had requested that I return for the beginning of the week. I returned to work at MacCosham's on Monday morning.

I did not know any of Gail Millar's friends except Linda Marwart & Betty Hundt.

After taking Gail Millar home I returned to 1308 Temperance. I arrived back about 2:30 am. I had another drink or two before going to bed.

I went to bed about 4:15 am or 4:30 am at this time I was listening in on a phone call that had been made by Bryon Odegard to a Linda who lives on the 800 block Temperance. I do not know her last name, but it is a corner house and she has a room in the basement. I got up about 11:30 am.

At this time Sig Holle and Bryon Odegard also present. I saw Forrest & Linda sleeping. We tried disturbing them by phone and making noise.

I never left 1308 Temperance after taking Gail home and until I got up about 11:30 pm.

at Swift Current, Sask. WENDY's last name is unknown and her address also. In the letters to Les and Wendy, it would appear that Gail MILLER was having problems with Les SPENCE and was attempting to break off relations with him. She was being unable to convince him that she wanted to break up.

Also in the room was a bill from a Dr. DUGGELBY, 102 Medical Bldg., 217-3rd Ave., which was not seized. Inquiries were made at Dr. DUGGELBY's office and it was learned from the office that Gail MILLER had attended at the Emergency ward of the Hospital complaining of dizziness and headaches and was attended by Dr. DUGGELBY. A check was also made of the room for a pareing knife but none was found and a knife which was very similar to the one which was (the blade of which) found at the scene of this crime, was brought to the Police Stn. along with a calander pad which lists dates with names and probably birthdays and also indications of breaking up with Les SPENCE and going with Les SPENCE during the year 1968.

Nick CANTON, Zack CANTON, and Hugo TENCZACA, 130 Ave. 0. S., who live together in two rooms, were interviewed separately without learning anything concerning the death of Gail Miller. The rooms occupied by these three men were searched with their assistance and permission. Nothing was located in the rooms to connect them with this offence and all seemed very sincere and were extremely co-operative.

Interviews were conducted at 1308 Temperance St. by N/Sgt. Oleksyn, Det. Karst and myself. Sigstad HOLLe is employed by the R.C.M.P. as a guard and gave a story which later verified a story given by Dennis ELLIOTT who returned home from Indian Head at 9:45 p.m., while we were present at the suite. Statements made by HOLLE were also consistant with those given by Betty HUNDT as to the people that attended. HOLLE, when questioned, thought that Gail MILLER was a very up-right sort of person and did not believe that she had ever had sex relations and never gave him any cause to believe that she was interested in any sex relations with anyone. HOLLE also stated that when ELLIOTT came home after having been away for about an hour from aprox. 1:20 to 2:20 or 2:30, that he had come home very jublient and that he made remarks about haveing kissed Gail MILLER good-night and also having made a date with her for Fri. night. Stated that the rest of the people at the apartment had continued drinking and that at about 4:30 a.m. ELLIGTT was in bed monitoring a phone call which had been made by Brian ODEGARD to some girl acquaintance of all of them who were present. This occurred at about 4:30 a.m., at which time ELLIOTT had gone to bed and was listening to an extension phone in his room. ELLIOTT had apparently got up between 10:00 and 11:00 at which time he woke HOLLE and Forest STUDER with whom Linda MARKWART had spent the night. This was a similar story to which ELLIOTT gave when he was interviewed on his arrival home. ELLIOTT also advised that he recalls that when he wad taken MIILER home he recalled a 1963 or 64 Pontiac with redist bottom, light colored top, with considerable damage to left rear fender or quarter pannel. There was a lone occupant in this vehicle who watched them and when he looked towards thisvehicle the man in

the vehicle looked away quickly. To his knowlege Gail was not aware of this vehicle. After he walked MILLER to the house at 130 Ave. 0. S. this vehicle was still present and the operator watching him when he returned to his vehicle, and he felt that he was about 10° away from this person on the street when he returned to get into his vehicle. This Pontiac auto was parked on the west side of Ave. 0. facing south across the street from 130 Ave. 0. S. He described the male person in this vehicle as haveing dark hair, combed back, possibly about his own height and build of 150-160 bbs., about 5°10" tall. He stated that this person was not Les SPENCE as SPENCE was known to him.

All rooms in the basement at 1308 Temperance St. were searched but nothing was found to connect any person with any part of this murder. All the persons at 1308 Temperance St. were found to be co-operative with Police and most anxious to assist in any way they could in regards to this investigation.



Approximately one week before Gail MILLER's murder I had met her at a party at my house on 1308 Temperance Street, Saskatoon. At that time Gail was with a fellow by the name of Dwaine or Dwight, I don't recall his last name. This fellow was a friend of Brian ODEGARD, who had a light housekeeping room in the basement. Dwaine/Dwight was a dirty blonde fellow, who was short and stocky. This party was actually the first time I met Gail. Approximately one week later I phoned her up and invited her to a party at our place again. I cannot recall exactly whether I picked her up or if she came to my place with others. stayed at the party and I drove her home around 5 - 5:30 in the morning. I was driving a 1965 Plymouth Fury II, maroon. I gave a complete statement to police shortly after Gail's death. I can state that I did not have sexual contact with Gail MILLER and any seminal fluid or stains found on her clothing or near the scene of the crime are not mine. I walked her to the door on the Avenue O entrance to her residence. I made a date to pick her up at 8:00 pm that night. I kissed her goodnight then left. This was the only date that I ever had with Gail MILLER. necessary, I am willing to provide a blood sample for whatever testing you believe necessary.
