Further to the statement that you have shown me today, I can remember walking north along the east sidewalk of Ave O. That was the 300 block. It was at a spot about 3 houses north of CADRAIN's where I found the wallet. I looked through the wallet for money. There was none in it. As I was searching through it, I discarded several pieces of identification and then took the wallet and hid it under the shack in the school yard. I went home for supper and then went back and got the wallet which I took to RAMANDA's to show my friend. Mrs. RAMANDA called the police when she saw that I found the wallet. There was a picture and some other I.D. still in the wallet which alerted Mrs. RAMANDA where it had come form

A uniformed policeman in a car arrived and I went with him back to where I had found the wallet. He searched the yard where I had discarded the pieces of I.D. from the wallet. I don't recall a policeman writing a statement and I have no idea if the statement which I obviously signed was taken in the police car, my home or RAMANDA's house.

At the time I was nine years old and I don't remember much about the policeman. I don't think I had any other contact with the police until I was at the trial.

Since that time I have not been contacted by any other person to discuss this matter.
