At 2:30 P.M., I received a brown leather folding wallet with a snap closure from Mrs. REMANDA 224 Ave. N. So. Mrs. REMANDA stated her son Norman and Giles BEAUCHAMP 8 yrs. of age 1305 20th St. W. had brought the wallet to the house. I then took REMANDA & BEAUCHAMP to where they had found the wallet and they took me to the area in front of 326 Ave. O. So. where they pointed to a pile of snow on the boulevard and BEAUCHAMP stated that he had been walking along Ave. C. and kicking the snow and the wallet flew out. On checking this area, just on the edge of the sidewalk, I found two hospitalization cards bearing the name of Gail MILLER.

This wallet is presently stored in my locker D 17 where it has been placed in a plastic bag until it dries. The wallet has not been examined for contents due to the possibility of some success in a fingerprint examination.

A short statement was taken from BEAUCHAMP boy in regard to his finding this wallet.
