At approximately 4:20 P.M. this date, March 2nd., 1969, Det. Hein and myself called at the Hounjet residence at 227 - Ave. N. South where Richard HOUNJET, 7 Yrs. DOB Sept. 2/61 turned over to me a knife handle which he stated he found at approximately 4:00 P.M. this date in his back yard. This knife handle was about 3 or 4 inches under the surface of the snow at a point which was measured by Det. Hein as 14 paces east of the North - South lane and 7 paces north of the East - West lane. The snow at this point would be at least 1 foot deep. Richard Hounjet marked this handle in my presence by placing an "X" on the side of same with a needle.

At approximately 4:30 P.M. this date, a witness statement was received by myself from Richard Hounjet.

The knife handle ~~which~~ is approx. 4" in length with about 1/8" of the broken blade sticking out. It is of a plastic type material and is a best red color.

At approximately 4:45 P.M. this date, I turned this knife handle over to Ident. Officer Kleiv, after scratching my initials "G.M." on same. I/O Kleiv also marked this handle at the same time.

It is believed this could be the handle of the weapon used in the stabbing murder of Gail Miller on Jan. 31/69.
