At 9.10 a.m. January 31, 1969 accompanied by Lieutenant Penkala and Cat. Winter, arrived at a scene of a madder, in the west alley which runs north and south in the 200 block Avenue N. South. This alley rums north and south between Avenue N. and Avenue O. On arrival at the scene Det. Parker and D/Sgt. Reid were in attendance. The scene was approached via the east-west alley from the 200 blk. Ave. N. So. to a point where the north-south alley joins the east-west alley. A blue blanket was spread ever the body on arrival. It was located on the east side of the alley, with the head to the south and feet to the north, lying on stomach, face down. There was evidence of the snow being packed down on the east side of the bedy. The body was clothed in a black coat, black fur collar and cuffs, was bare headed and was that of a female. There was an overboot on the left foot and girdle, panties and stocking down over left boot. No boot on right foot, stocking down ambove ankle. Left and right stockings were attached to girdle fasteners. There were red spots in various locations about the body which were consistant with being blood. Two gloves were found in the snow on the east side of the alley, south of the body, one from left hand and one right hand both tan colored and in separate places in the anow.

At 10.05 a.m. I accompanied Ray's Ambulance with body to St. Pauls Hospital. Attendants of the Ambulance were Peter Funk and Brian Dueck who both reside at 116 Ave. H. No. Body was taken to Emergency area to Room #3. I remained with the body. Dr. Rogel arrived at Room #3 at approximately 10.40 a.m. at which time he asked me to make arrangements to impanel a Jury.

At 11.45 a.m. Det. Parker and D/Sgt. Reid brought a girl by name of Vicky Fontains to identify the body. She identified boy as thet of Gall Miller.

3.20 pm.

At 12.20 p.m., Jury members along with Dr. Fogel, Inspector Nerdatrum and Vicky Fontaine, came to Room #3 to view body.

At 2.30 p.m., Lieutenant Pankala and I attended at the autopsy conducted by Dr. Enson. The body was clothed in black overcoat, black for collar and cuffs. Brassier had right strap torn and blood stained. White dress bleed stained with name tag Miss. G. Miller, brown hair adhering to elasp, button Saskatchewan Institute of Applied Arts and Sciences Nursing Assistant. Zipper on back broken, dress was tern in seem on left front below collar. Blood stained half slip along with dress were positioned at approximately waist height. The sleeves on the dress were not torn which would indicate that the dress was removed eff the shoulders and arms by removing the coat and after placing the coat back on. Black everbedt on left foot, girdle, panties and white stocking same down over boot. No boot on right foot, stocking eff leg down to ankle, stockings were attached to the girdle. Girdle was blood stained and parties were blood stained in the erotch area.
