On Jan. 31/69 at 8:40 a.m. I received a telephone call from a lady who gave her name as Mrs. Patty Hnatiuk and her address as 219 Ave. N So. Mrs Hnatiuk sounded excited and said that some children had found a lady lying in the lane of the rear of her address and she appeared to be murdered. I informed her that a car would be sent over right away. I informed Supt. Wood of the call and he immediately sent Car #11 on this call with D/Sgt. Reid and Det. Parker being in this car.

At 8:42 I received another call this one from a Terry Michaluk of 1402 20th St. W., and he stated that he had just been told of a lady in the lane near the Westwood Funeral Chapel where he was employed and upon checking he had seen a woman who appeared to be dead with some blood around the area. He said that the body had been covered with a blanket.

At 8:55 a.m. I called the home of Dr. Fogal and advised him of the location of the body and that he was required at the scene.

At 9:00 a.m. I called Rays Ambulance to attend at the scene at 200 block Ave. N So.

On Jan. 31/69 I was assigned to Detective office duties 8:00a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
