Mr. Terry Michayliuk states as follows:

I am the assistant manager at Westwood Funeral Chapel located 1402 - 20 St. West, Saskatoon and I also reside at this address.

At approx. 8:30 a.m. or 8:35 a.m. on January 31, 1969, I was informed by Rae Murdock that apparently a woman was lying in the lane and if I would go with him.

I put my coat on and went with Mr. Rae Murdock - in the lane I saw a girl who pointed out the body to me. In the lane which was north and south in the 200 block Avenue N. South I observed a woman lying face down in the snow. I kinda tugged at this womans shoulder and also spoke to her - I turned her over a bit - but then I saw that she was dead. I returned to the chapel and I phoned the police. The ambulance was notified by Mrs. Joan Murdock.

After notifying the police Dept. I picked up a blue blanket and took it with back to where this woman was lying and I covered this woman with this blanket. I stayed at the scene with Mr. Murdock until the police arrived.

When I first went to the place were this woman was lying - I noticed she was lying face down - facing in a southerly direction. I noticed her clothing was disarranged and was wearing a coat. The snow around the body appeared to have been messed up and the odd spot blood near her in the snow.

This is all that I can remember about this matter at this time
