A guy and girl returned and were in the way in the shop and asked them to stay out as business was brisk that morning. He feels about two hours of work was done and the group left after paying cash and he did not see them again.

He said the "kids" were kind of hyper and they were trying to (and did) throw out garbage from the vehicle.

He did not recall the police attending the garage that day. He thought they came in March or April to look for the invoice re: the repairs and he was interviewed, he believes, by Eddie Maest or his partner.

He recalls there was something wrong with the heater and transmission line, the reverse gear etc. It was a '58 or '59 Chev or Pontiac



Please be advised that we are currently inquiring into the circumstances surrounding the murder of Miss Gail MILLER, which occurred in Saskatoon, Sask. on 69-JAN-31. David Edgar MILGAARD was tried for, and convicted of this offence in 1970 and was released from prison following a decision rendered by the Supreme Court of Canada in 1992.

Our investigation is the result of certain allegations made by Mr. MILGAARD's lawyer, Mr. Hersh WOLCH, of Winnipeg. Although we are not tasked with the responsibility of reinvestigating the offence itself, we are conducting certain inquiries with individuals who may, or may not, have been questioned by the Saskatoon Police Force at the time of the murder.

One such witness is Mr. Fred ALEXANDER, who now resides in Gold River at #8 Peppercorn Trails, telephone 283-2093. Mr. ALEXANDER apparently works in some capacity for a pulp mill within your jurisdiction and can be reached at 283-2869. Mr. ALEXANDER resided in Saskatoon in 1969 and is the former owner and operator of Hillcrest Texaco, a business at which the accused apparently attended after the offence.

Would you please contact Mr. ALEXANDER with a view to obtaining a written statement from him regarding what he recalls of the circumstances of 69-JAN-31. I have spoken to him and he is aware that a member will be contacting him. I have appended a list of questions which will assist during the interview.





- he believes Kyle MOST was working for him at the time and that either MOST or John KARLSON were dispatched to retrieve the car out of the snowbank.

- Dave ANDERSON, he believes, (ANDERSON is the tow truck driver), may now be residing in Edmonton and in fact, may be a lawyer. His father, FNU, did live in Saskatoon.
