I would submit that the file be concluded, given the inconsistencies in BEDFORD'S statements. We will be interviewing ~~Mr.~~ Verno PASSET, and Mrs. BEDFORD will be discussed at that time.

SYNOPSIS

BEDFORD was inconsistent with her previous statements made to Francis PETRIE, now stating that three men were responsible for the murder of Gail MILLER rather than two men and a woman. PETRIE confirmed that BEDFORD drank heavily in 1969 and it is possible that this may have affected her perception. She told the ~~investigative~~ members that the police had not contacted her about the murder but then reported and said they perhaps did. File concluded based on these inconsistencies.

930210 13:40 Pst. Cunningham and I attended to 234 Ave E N, Saskatoon where we spoke to Mrs. BEFORDS. Her story had changed somewhat from the account of Mr. PERRIE and indeed, from when I spoke to her yesterday. She advised me that she had^{not} been spoken to by police whereas today, she states that she might have been. In any event, we found ~~to~~ Mrs. BEFORDS to be very sharp, (especially given that she is 80 years old) and easy to speak with. A statement was not obtained for reasons which are apparent below. Mrs. BEFORDS stated that:

- she saw three men (notice contrast to PERRIE's statement) grab a woman at the 30th St + Ave O bus stop. All men wore heavy coats and dragged a girl into an alley.

- one man was responsible
