Gail told her she did not like walking 20<sup>th</sup> Street, PETERS does not know why however thought that it was because there had been a lot of young kids hanging around and was known as a 'rough' street.

A: I can't even remember maybe a couple months we all had our own rooms, there was about at least 8 on the floor we were on, there was a main floor and a little loft, there was one girl living in the loft. I don't know how many living on the main floor. There was a couple spanish fellows living on the main floor, I know there were two suites on the main floor. The vehicles we parked in the back. It was so cold I don't know if my car started. My dad had to come out & get me. We were all scared shiteless, a lot of us girls didn't stay there that night.

Q. How often did you give Gail Miller a ride to work?

A. I don't remember, it was quite a few times, whenever my car would start. Sometimes I went with my dad so she took the bus. She would take the bus, leave a little earlier. Sometimes I didn't come home. On the days that were decent I would drive. She always, unless her boyfriend came, seems to me she always left using Ave. O. to get to the bus. She would never take the back alley. It was too dark at least in the front there was a couple lights.

I don't remember if Gail was leaving there before me or after I got there. It was so long ago.

Q. Do you recall if Gail was or had any intentions of moving?

A. I don't know. We all got along. We had a room that we sat and watched T.V. and listened to music. I didn't know Gail very well, she wasn't always

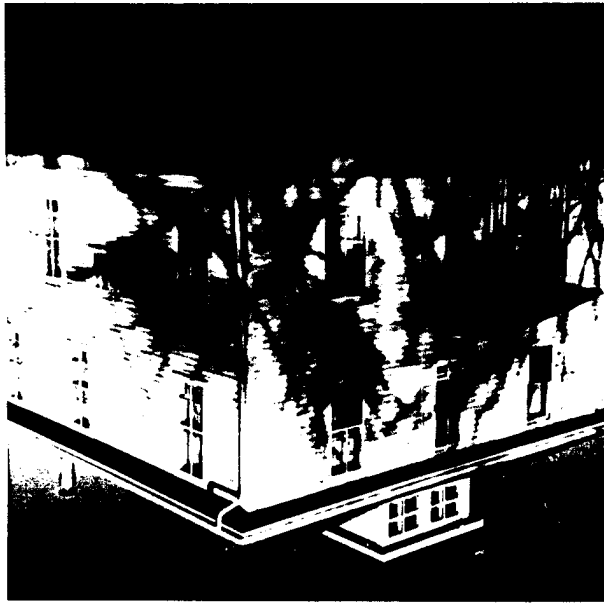

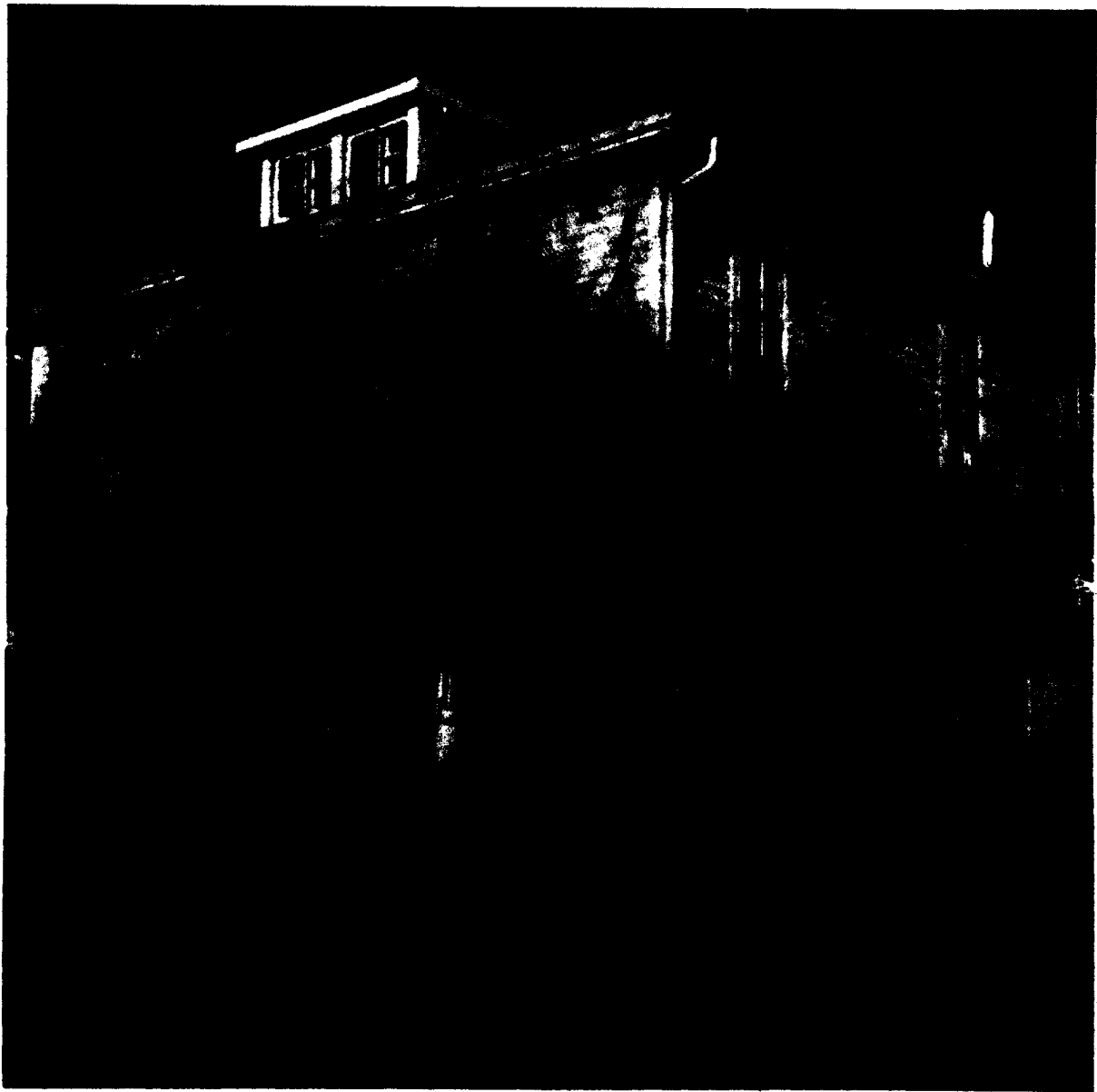
The last time I saw Paul was on
