After that invitation he indicates meeting who he believes to be David MILGAARD and the two tried, without success, to borrow some money from him to go to Calgary. After getting no money they left GORGCHUK'S place.

He is currently between jobs. He has legally changed his name from WYTOWICH to GORGCHUCK. (He explained the reason for changing his last name, which had nothing to do with the MILGAARD matter.)

Subject was initially spoken to by ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~. He did not recall who took his statement back on 69-04-17. He didn't go to the Police. They came to see him, which he feels was the result of their contact with Albert CADRAIN. Does not recall giving any other statements after the 69-04-17 one. Does not recall the Police contacting him at anytime after his 69-04-17

Subject was given his statement of 69-04-17 to read. He indicated that the statement was not in his writing. He was satisfied with the contents of the statement, with one exception. This being the reference to the amounts of drugs being used. He felt that the detail in this area was somewhat heavier than actual fact. He did not feel that his statement had been tampered with in any way. He was not mistreated, pressured or influenced in any way / at anytime by anyone from the S'ton P.D. with regards to the MILGAARD/MILLER investigation.

Subject spoke very highly of Albert CADRAIN and obviously (to us) considered CADRAIN a

close friend. He recalls his last contact with CADRAIN to be 5 to 6 yrs ago when CADRAIN was working as either a baker or a baker's assistant at the Super Store in S'toon. He also indicated that CADRAIN had been working as a short order cook at the Bessborough Hotel in S'toon. Subject recalls going to the Super Store one day to see CADRAIN, only to learn that CADRAIN had quit without giving notice. Subject attributes CADRAIN's sudden departure from that job because of Joyce MILGAARD, who apparently was continually trying to get a hold of him.

Subject was married in 1980, at which time he moved to Lanigan and worked at a Potash mine out there. Subject's wife recalls receiving a call one

day from a person describing themselves as a Private Eye who had been hired by Joyce MILGAARD to locate the subject in order to find out where CADRAIN was.

After spending a couple of years in Lanigan the subject and his wife moved back to S'ton, where they have remained to date. According to subject Joyce MILGAARD phoned him sometime during the 1980's. She was looking for CADRAIN. While subject could not specifically recall what Mrs. MILGAARD had to say, he described her as pushy and suggestive in tone.

Subject first met CADRAIN at St Mary's School in S'ton. Later on they both worked in Muller's Hatchery in S'ton.

Subject described Albert as a nice, easy going guy. That Albert's brothers were considered as bullies in school.

Subject recalls CADRAIN coming over to his place on 69-01-31. Subject was not specific as to the time of day, however it would appear to have been in the afternoon. That Albert had been to his place the day before and they did some marijuana. Subject did not seem to feel that Albert left his place high that day. (Subject believes that in the past he only did LSD twice and one of the occasions might have been with CADRAIN, however, the LSD use does not relate to 69-01-30/31.) When Albert came to his place on 69-01-31 he wanted the subject to come to Calgary. Subject described CADRAIN as nervous

and continually asking him to come along to Calgary. Subject did not want to go on the trip as it was to short a notice and he had just gotten back from his trip to Regina with CADRAIN. While Albert was at his place a fellow came in and wanted to use the bathroom. Subject doesn't recall being introduced to this fellow, however, stated that sometime after Albert told him that it was MILGAARD. A fellow that he and CADRAIN saw in Regina on their trip a week before. Subject showed the fellow (MILGAARD) to the bathroom and outside the bathroom, while MILGAARD was using the washroom, Albert, whispering, asked subject over and over again to come along to Calgary. That CADRAIN did not appear comfortable about the trip. Subject described Albert as apprehensive about the trip and got

the impression that Albert said not want to go on the trip. CADRAIN and MILGAARD left. They were only at his house for about ten minutes. Thinks that before leaving his place Albert might have wanted to borrow some money. That Albert was not high on dope on 09-01-31 when subject saw CADRAIN after the trip. (Sometime before Court) He described CADRAIN as spooked, concerned & troubled. That Albert was not the care free person that he was before the trip.

Subject feels that CADRAIN was not the same person after the trip. Subject does not recall Albert ever telling him anything. After the Court case Albert did mention that he saw blood on MILGAARD's pants and main-
 tains what he felt he saw. That Albert was worried that MILGAARD

Subject doesn't believe that CADRAIN has lied in any way. He said that doesn't remember if Albert told him about receiving the reward money, however, he did hear about it. Subject has / had never known CADRAIN to be a money chaser (as he put it). Subject does not believe that Albert would lie to get money.

Questioned subject as to whether CADRAIN could have killed MILLER and subject did not feel he could have.

Subject stated that he was never called by the Prosecutor in the MILGAARD case. That he did not testify.
