The captionally noted was interviewed by Inspector A. R. Roberts in Edmonton on the evening of June 11, 1969 regarding her knowledge of David Milgaard and the Gail Miller murder.

Miss Williams was interrogated with the use of the Polygraph for approximately 3½ hours. It is the opinion of Inspector A. Roberts that Miss Williams does not have any information that would assist you in the prosecution of David Milgaard. She did state, however, that she remembers Milgaard saying, "I tried to make a girl in Saskatoon."

Inquiries regarding the relationship between a William Wuttunee, Barrister and Solicitor in the city of Calgary, and the Wuttunee involved in your incident reveal that they are distant cousins and there is no reason to believe that there is any other connection.

There were no expenses involved with respect to the interview with Miss Williams.
